Leonie Moyle - Bio

Dr Leonie Moyle is a Professor of Biology at Indiana University, Bloomington. She received her PhD in Biology from Duke University, and was a Center for Population Biology Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of California, Davis. Research in her group addresses the genetics and ecology of speciation and adaptation, focusing on Solanaceous group including Solanum and Jaltomata. Current areas of interest include: quantifying comparative genome evolution in the Solanaceae; examining the genomic changes that accompany rapid species radiations; testing theory about the accumulation of reproductive isolation with empirical data; and, examining the interplay between intraspecific reproductive interactions and interspecific reproductive isolation.
