Greg Martin - Bio

Greg Martin is a Professor in the School of Integrative Plant Science at Cornell University and the Boyce Schulze Downey Professor at the Boyce Thompson Institute for Plant Research. His laboratory uses the interaction of tomato with the bacterial pathogen Pseudomonas syringae pv. tomato to investigate the molecular mechanisms that underlie bacterial infection processes and the plant immune system. In the past 30 years, Martin has supervised the research projects of over 90 undergraduate students, and mentored 16 graduate students and 37 postdoctoral associates.
